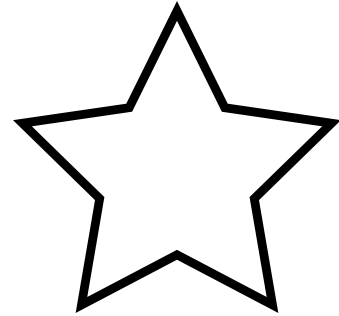


FORM

The element of form refers to shapes that have three dimensions.

Forms have height, width, and depth.
They can be viewed from multiple angles.

vanishing point



One point perspective is one of the easiest ways to make shapes into forms. One point perspective uses a horizon line and a single vanishing point to create a sense of depth. Draw lines from the "edges" of shapes back to the vanishing point.
