

## HINTS & TIPS



- 1.You will need:
- Loo roll
- Basic drawing or painting equipment
- Possibly an image for inspiration



Once you've got an image in mind, you can draw/paint it straight on to the loo roll or you could draw a light / rough guide to want you want to draw before starting.





3. Don't forget this is a three-dimensional piece of art, your drawing / painting should stretch at least two thirds of the way around, if not all the way around! Consider your full composition before you start.

4. Don't forget to be resourceful....even with a basic biro pen you can apply tone and shade with cross-hatching. If you want to paint but don't have any paints, what about using tea / coffee for staining or use food colouring?





5. Above all...have FUN & ENJOY!
